Due to space limitations, parking passes are restricted to two per vendor. All other vendor employees, not traveling with the pass holders, will be required to park at one of the high schools and take a shuttle bus to the airport. Be sure to coordinate the parking/shuttling requirements with the rest of your participating party. Any vehicle without an assigned parking pass will not be authorized to enter. Sorry, no exceptions.

General Vendor Policies and Requirements

The Air Fest vendor area was full in 2025. We will give priority to previous participants who submit their completed vendor package applications and fees by August 31, 2026. After that date, new vendors will be accepted, if space allows.

- Vendors are responsible for providing their own tables, tent(s), and other necessary equipment.
- Food Vendors must acquire applicable Health Department permits, if necessary, and all vendors must provide liability insurance naming Culpeper County as the co-insured.
- Space constraints at the Air Fest often limit the number of vendors. The Culpeper Air Fest Committee has adopted a general policy of giving priority to businesses and organizations based in Culpeper County, as well as those providing aviation-related products and services.
- The Culpeper Air Fest Committee will assign a vendor space location.
- Set up - You are required to select a date and time from below when you will arrive for set-up. **Food vendors must set up on Friday, October 9th, with no exceptions, to ensure enough space is available for all food providers and equipment. You can be denied entry if you do not set up when required.**

_____ I will set-up Saturday from 6:30 AM to 7:30 AM.

Authorized vendor vehicles with passes must be parked in the designated area by 8:00am. All vendor traffic on the tarmac will cease when shuttle busses arrive. Plan early, set up early. No exceptions.

- Take-down will be permitted only after the air show ends on Saturday to prevent foreign object debris. All dismantling within vendor spaces must be completed by 6:00pm Saturday evening.
- Vendor names will be included in promotional materials when possible.

The application fee is waived for Air Fest sponsors, non-profits, public service, community, and educational organizations that will only have informational displays. All vendor selections will be completed by September 15th, 2026. The fee will be refunded to vendors who are not selected for participation. The Air Fest Foundation reserves the right to refuse a vendor spot for any vendor.

Participating vendors acknowledge and accept that weather and other factors may influence audience size or may force the Air Fest to be rescheduled for an alternate date. The fee becomes non-refundable upon being selected as a vendor and will not be refunded in the event of inclement weather or cancellation of Air Fest, as determined by the committee.
